

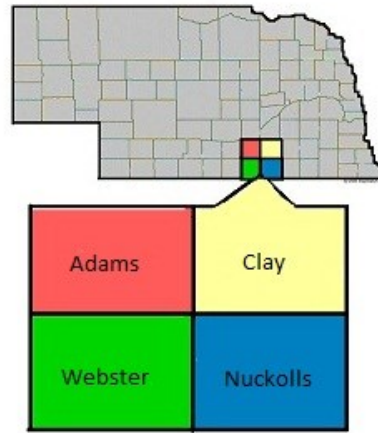

## Here are just a few examples of the services provided to your community:

**687** residents were provided with current, easily accessible information for individuals and families who were dealing with substance abuse and recovery issues through ASAAP's Lending Library

**25** youth participated in programs that build character, citizenship, and develops personal fitness through Boy Scouts programs

**106** individuals received Family Support services from Catholic Social Services in the form of Emergency assistance needing food, clothing, furniture, medicine and/or help with rent or utilities

**55** individuals received monthly supplemental food packages through Community Action of Mid-Nebraska's C.S.F.P program

**15** children were matched one-on-one with positive adult role models who are their friends and mentors through Big Brothers Big Sisters

**11** senior citizens received services through Senior Action

**2** family caregivers gained the tools, knowledge and confidence they need to continue caring for a loved with special needs right in their own home by Hastings Respite Care

**15** individuals received education to after they completed an intensive treatment program at Horizon Recovery and Counseling Center

**26** individuals received support, guidance, and education through the SASA Center for a life free of domestic and sexual violence

**\$352.92** in gas vouchers were provided by Special Children's Fund to families with children who were urgently transported to hospitals away from home to treat illnesses

**15** children were provided trained, court appointed, community volunteers to advocate for them through CASA of South Central Nebraska

**392** individuals received services from Y.W.C.A of Adams County
