### \$40 A WEEK (\$2,080 ANNUALLY)

Provides 1 hour one on one tutoring for 40 children through the Foster Grandparent Program.

### \$5 A WEEK (\$260 ANNUALLY)

Provides a woman with career clothing and help her prepare for future employment with resume and application assistance.

### \$20 A WEEK (\$1,040 ANNUALLY)

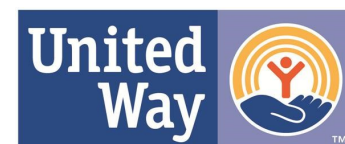
Provides 20 nurse home visits that will save the community up to 50% in special education costs by providing early intervention and education that will protect children from further developmental delays.
